Collect

First Reading Numbers 21:4-9

After enduring a plague of serpents, the Israelites repent of their wrongdoing. On God's instructions Moses makes a bronze serpent. Whenever someone is bitten, they look at the bronze serpent and live.

Second Reading Philippians 2:6-11

The passage reveals the cross as the heart of Jesus' mission. Yet having reached that goal, it was never God's intention to stay there. Through the resurrection, God lifts us to new life.

Gospel John 3:13-17

"God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life." The unmistakable indication that Jesus is referring to the cross is in the words "lifted up".
