This year the Season of Creation is focussing on the links between creation and peace in our world. The key Bible verse is Isaiah 32:14-18

"14 The fortress will be abandoned, the noisy city deserted; citadel and watchtower will become a wasteland for ever, the delight of donkeys, a pasture for flocks,

- <sup>15</sup> till the Spirit is poured on us from on high, and the desert becomes a fertile field, and the fertile field seems like a forest.
- <sup>16</sup> The Lord's justice will dwell in the desert, his righteousness live in the fertile field.
- <sup>17</sup> The fruit of that righteousness will be peace; its effect will be quietness and confidence for ever.
- <sup>18</sup> My people will live in peaceful dwelling-places, in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest."
