### IMPORTANT NOTICE - DATA BREACH BY APCS LTD


IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM REV CHRIS GRASSKE
In the last few days, I have made aware that the company that
processes the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks for the
Diocese of Salisbury, has had its clients data stolen due to a data hack.
I am officially the data controller for this benefice. The data
leaked includes National Insurance and driving licence numbers as
well as date of birth, so a serious data breach.

At the moment I do not know how many people in this benefice are affected, but it is likely limited to those who have had a DBS check in the past year or so.

Those affected seem to be being contacted directly from the external company, APCS, Access Personal Checking Services Ltd,

If those who have been notified could let me know, it will enable me to understand the extent of the breach as far as this benefice is concerned. Thank you.

10.30am - 4.30pm.


The exhibition will include work by Charlotte Miller, John Boyd and Marion

### <u>Dorset Historic Churches Trust Ride+Stride – Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September</u>

#### RIDE+STRIDE

Every year Dorset Historic Churches Trust runs a sponsored Ride+Stride event and invites everybody to take part.

This heritage organisation raises money to support the repair and maintenance of our historic church buildings. Half of the money raised is returned to the nominated Church or Chapel and Dorset Historic Churches Trust use the balance to give grants to maintain historic Dorset churches.

### Taking part

- ✓ People walk, run, ride a bicycle, a horse or a mobility scooter and plan a route to visit Dorset churches.
- ✓ There is no specified number of churches to be visited between 10am and 6pm. The start and finish can be at any location a good opportunity to explore a new area of Dorset.
- ✓ This is for individuals or groups of people. Anyone can take part.
- ✓ It could be a family day out. Children are welcome if accompanied by an adult.

### Sponsorship

- ✓ Sponsorship could be for the number of churches visited, miles covered or an amount for taking part.
- ✓ Money can be raised through a Just Giving page or a traditional sponsorship form.
- ✓ Half the money raised through sponsorship is returned to the nominated church.


