Sunday 2 <sup>nd</sup> November	All Age Holy Communion – All Saints' Day

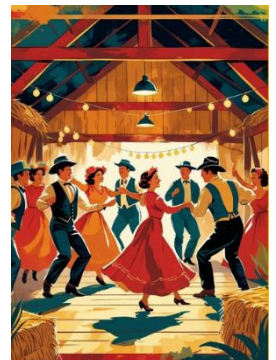

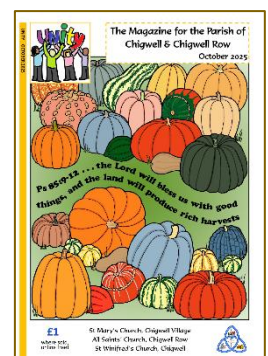
### Other meetings
