

A call to seek the face of the Lord

Desiring to know and experience God's presence and favour is known as "seeking the face of the Lord." This is different from merely pursuing his provisions or material blessings. It comprises establishing a close, intimate relationship with God through prayer, worship, scripture meditation, and a commitment to living according to divine precepts, which includes making time for God, concentrating on his characteristics and presence, and acknowledging his revelations and inspirations. Some people think that fasting can help them become closer to God and increase their spiritual fervour.

There are many advantages to seeking the face of the Lord, such as discovering God's presence, finding inner joy, peace, and security, receiving divine wisdom, strength, and guidance for life's obstacles, and undergoing transformation and renewal. Seeking God's face helps foster a closer relationship with God and a more profound sense of His love. It can also lead to spiritual success, blessings, and provision.

I want to encourage us, as Psalm 105:4 says, 'Always seek the face of the LORD and his strength'.
