



VE Day 80 commemoration service at Crowan Church

8<sup>th</sup> May, the 80th anniversary of VE Day, saw the band taking part in a service at beautiful St Crewenna's Church in the parish of Crowan near Praze-an-Beeble.

We wanted to play an active role in the national day of remembrance commemorating the sacrifices made by the Second World War generation.

Reverend Rory Clare conducted the evening service, which was attended by members of the regular congregation as well as visitors.

We played some light-hearted WW2 themed music including "Aces High", "Dad's Army", and "Dambusters' March". Then to set a more contemplative mood, we chose John Williams' lovely "Hymn to the Fallen" from "Saving Private Ryan".

Ceremonial beacons were lit across the UK at 9.30pm as we accompanied the hymn "I Vow to Thee My Country".

The congregation certainly did it justice. Royal pageant-master Bruno Peek CVO chose that particular hymn to be sung by the nation because, as he put it, "I felt there must be something that can bring people together, that they can sing with a simple heart. They're singing for the fallen soldiers but they're singing it together."

The service was concluded with the National Anthem followed by the theme from "The Great Escape", to put a smile on people's faces as they made their way out of church.


