





# A few places are left for First Aid Training

# Friday 10 October 2025 at St Michael's Church 9.30am to 4.30pm

We have organised a First Aid course, for 12 persons, in St Michael's lasting for one day, 9.30am to 4.30pm, Friday 10 October 2025. The course title is Emergency First Aid at Work and the provider is First Response.

We can provide coffee/tea and biscuits. Trainees are asked to bring a packed lunch.

Guidance includes wearing sensible clothes and being of reasonable fitness.

It is important to remember that the duties of a first aider can be physically demanding, so attendees must be free from any condition that will affect their participation in the course and their capability to carry out a first aider's duties. For example, individuals must be able to physically kneel on the floor and administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

This is a whole day commitment and we are very grateful to anyone who takes it on. This activity fits in well with Mission Statement in two ways. We are trained and prepared to deliver careful and caring attention to any persons in our church community who need First Aid. We are trained and prepared to bring help to anyone we come across in our daily lives.

If you wish to sign up for this course, please reply to me, Ann Jessop, email below, directly with your name, your role, your email and a phone number. I hope to have a list of 12 persons confirmed by Friday 26 September.

If you already hold a valid and in-date First Aid qualification, maybe via your place of work, and would like the church to know you are trained and available in an emergency, please let me know.
