Penponds Church: 2-4pm, every Tuesday

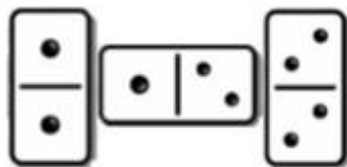

BF Adventures 2025

May I start by saying a massive thank you to Camborne church for their incredible generosity in paying for these 12 young people to have a really fun day.

The day started in Tesco car park where the minibus had arranged to meet the young people at 9am. Once we were all gathered we made our way to the venue, BF Adventure.

Upon arrival we were met by Ben our instructor for the day who took us to our first activity, kayak rafting. As the young people got into their wetsuits Ben strapped together kayaks in twos to make rafts for 4 people. They then took them out on the water and played games involving races and collecting balls from the water. At the end of the session they had the opportunity to jump in the water from a pontoon and most of them took up that offer



The kayak session took us to lunch time. Becky prepared a fantastic spread which everyone enjoyed. We were then taken to the low ropes area where the young people took part in several activities that tested teamwork and problem solving. It was really lovely to see a group of young people, of which some didn't know others, really working well together. Brody said the day was "fun, challenging, and was great being with his friends doing team work activities"

My highlight was watching everyone support each other especially when others found it harder to do particular tasks. The swinging onto the platform task was a prime example.

We then moved to our final activity area, on the water. The YP had to work together to fill a pipe up with water which had loads of holes in it. They then had to make their way across the quarry on tyre lilly pads using only a few planks. By this point two of the youths had ended up in the water!! They found it really fun. The day ended at 3pm and we returned to Tesco where the young people were all picked up.

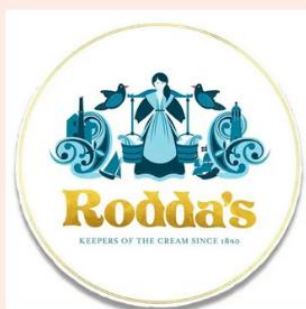
