REFILL Fridays 9am to 10.30am termtime, is a group for parents or carers to come and relax with a tea or coffee, have a biscuit or two and chat. Toys and space provided for preschoolers.

The Pantry still works closely with our local community and other community groups to provide a Food Bank to those in need in our area.

What Is The Pantry?

Our foodbank in Belton and Burgh Castle is called the Pantry.
Colin, Bob and Linda run it from our own church.
We are an independent food bank that is self-supporting.

Our referrals come from a variety of sources, usually from agencies completing forms to send to us.
We are also able to help those in our local community who are in need, and are happy to take referrals from you or anyone else who sees a need.

We initially offer three weeks of food parcels, but this can be extended if we assess the situation as requiring extra help.

At Christmas, we like to send hampers of festive food to help those who might otherwise be unable to afford the extras.

We appreciate monetary donations, but also donations of food.

Monetary donations can be made into the bank account with the reference of 'Pantry' or 'Foodbank'



The donations of money or food from our harvest festival will be used to meet the needs of people in our local area.
