As we begin our annual series on Creation there are all sorts of other beginnings at this time of year. The new academic year for schools, colleges and universities begins, and so for all those students anticipating first time experiences. I was hoping that there would be a new moon to add to my list but sadly it's not due for another two weeks. This is the time of year when we plant bulbs to begin their time in darkness before we bring them into the light. And today is the first Sunday of meteorological autumn – a change in the seasons as daylight length decreases. Our readings today both tell of beginnings direct from God - the account of the beginning of Creation from Genesis and of the beginning of Christianity from John's gospel. Do you have any new beginnings in your life? perhaps not with the enormity of those given to us by God. If not, maybe you could find a new beginning that would enhance your personal life and your life with God.
