Reflection By Revd Bart

Changing Seasons, Changing Lives

"The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever." (Isaiah 40:8)

As the seasons shift from the warmth of summer to the crispness of autumn, we are reminded once again of the beautiful rhythm God has woven into creation. Trees release their leaves, the days grow shorter, and the earth gently prepares for rest. In this natural transition, we see a spiritual parallel to the seasons of our own lives. I have reached a season change, turning 50 this year and seeing our second child leave home for University, has reminded me that

nothing stays the same and life looks a little different as I watch the leaves fall this October.

Just as nature doesn't resist the changing seasons, we too are invited to embrace the changes life brings, whether they be joyful or challenging. Ecclesiastes 3 tells us there is "a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." Life is filled with beginnings and endings, growth and stillness, celebration and sorrow. Yet in each moment, God remains constant. The Psalms also give voice to every human emotion we might experience through life's seasons. In Psalm 1, we're encouraged to be like a "tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither." What a comforting image, even when the world around us changes, people move away, and our bodies remind us of our age, those rooted in God will remain nourished and strong in heart and spirit.

And in Psalm 23, perhaps the most beloved of all, David writes, "Even though I walk through the valley... I will fear no evil, for you are with me." Whether we are on the mountaintop or in a season of waiting, God is present, faithful, and near. And, this is the hopeful and sustaining promise that helps us through all the transitions and changes we may face during our lives.

As a church family, let us support one another through our changing seasons. Let's celebrate births and new beginnings (of which there have been a few recently!), comfort those in grief, and walk together through uncertainty. Most of all, let's keep our eyes fixed on the One who never changes, Jesus Christ, "the same yesterday and today and forever" (Hebrews 13:8). May we find peace in the transitions and strength in the promise that God's love endures through every season of life.


We are again planning to support T4U by making up shoeboxes to be sent to Eastern Europe.






