REMEMBRANCE POPPIES

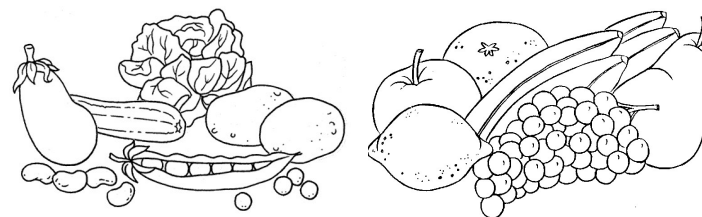
Don't forget that the locally
