On this day... 26th October 1863 in the Freemasons Tavern, London, the Football Association (FA) was formed. 11 clubs came together to agree the rules of football. Amongst them Crystal Palace and the Civil Service Football Club (which still exists). Some of the rules agreed upon were that a player was permitted to catch the ball with their hands and would then be entitled to a free kick. Another was that they kept the practice of having no crossbar on the goal posts. And they implemented a strict offside rule, whereby any player ahead of the ball was offside.
