Joel 2: 23-end: O children of Zion, be glad and rejoice in the Lord your God; for he has given early rain for your vindication, he has poured down abundant rain, early and later rain, as before. ²⁴ The threshing-floors will be full of grain, the vats shall overflow with wine and oil. ²⁵ I will repay you for the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the hopper, destroyer and the cutter, my great army, which I sent against you. ²⁶ You shall eat plenty and be satisfied and praise the name of the Lord your God, who has dealt wondrously with you. My people shall never again be put to shame. ²⁷ You shall know that I am in the midst of Israel and that I, the Lord, am your God; there is no other. My people shall never again be put to shame. ²⁸ Afterwards I will pour out my spirit on all flesh; your sons and daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams; your young men shall see visions. ²⁹ Even on the male and female slaves, in those days, I will pour out my spirit. 30 I will show portents in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke. ³¹ The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the great and terrible day of the Lord comes. 32 Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved; for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be those who escape, as the Lord has said, and among the survivors shall be those whom the Lord calls.

2 Timothy 4: 6-8; 16-18: ⁶ As for me, I am being poured out as a libation and the time of my departure has come. ⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸ From now on there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have longed for his appearing. ¹⁶ At my first defence no one came to my support, but all deserted me. May it not be counted against them! ¹⁷ But the Lord stood by me and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. I was rescued from the lion's mouth. ¹⁸ The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Luke 8: 9-14 ⁹ His disciples asked him what this parable meant. ¹⁰ He said, 'To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of God; but to others I speak in parables, so that "looking they may not perceive; listening they may not understand.' ¹¹ 'Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. ¹²The ones on the path are those who have heard; then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so they may not believe and be saved. ¹³The ones on the rock are those who, when they hear the word, receive it with joy; but have no root; they believe only for a while and in a time of testing fall away. ¹⁴As for what fell among thorns, these are ones who hear; but as they go on their way, are choked by the cares, riches and pleasures of life and their fruit does not mature.

<u>Collect:</u> Faithful Lord, whose steadfast love never ceases and whose mercies never come to an end: grant us the grace to trust you and to receive the gifts of your love, new every morning, in Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**
