Safeguarding Sunday

On 16th November 2025 our churches will be recognising Safeguarding Sunday 2025. This is an annual awareness-raising campaign coordinated by *Thirtyone:eight*, an Independent Christian Safeguarding charity, to help all churches across the UK share what they're doing to guard their Christian communities as safe places for everyone. The theme this year is 'Actions Speak Louder'.

During the service we'll be exploring how safeguarding is a demonstration of our Christian faith. We'll talk about the safeguarding arrangements our church has in place, and we'll be thanking the people involved who make this happen. This will be done in a sensitive way, using the resources produced by *Thirtyone:eight*.




