- A whole church meeting to be called on Sunday 12th October at 11:15 to discuss our response to prayers for same sex couples.
- Minster Communities we will be joining with villages to the west.
- Safeguarding we agreed to again adopt the national policy.
- Worship we agreed to have the same pattern of worship next Easter as last.
- Harvest Ist Sunday in October. A VJ Day and a Battle of Britain service were also planned.
- 8:30am Communions will be on the 2nd & 4th Sundays, while Rachael is with us. To be reviewed when she is not.
- We agreed to pay a parish share of at least £30,000 in 2026, but this only covers the pay of a full time Rector and not housing, NI, tax etc.
