WAR MEMORIALS - **AMENDED!**

There are three War Memorials at St George's. One, WWI, was brought from St Paul's, and one from the old St George's with the many names of those who died from the parish in WWI. The third, giving names, rank and branch of service, is a WW2 memorial from Christ Church. (The WWI Christ Church memorial is located in the garden there.) There is a currently a project initiated by the Imperial War Museum to gather all names from parish churches' memorials, so this information has been sent to them and to Lewisham Library. The memorials have now been photographed and transcribed, so please let me know if you might have a relative you'd like to trace or you're interested in the history of this area.

¹⁵ Since I heard of your faith in Jesus and your love for God's people, ¹⁶ I have not stopped giving thanks to God for you. I remember you in my prayers ¹⁷ and ask God to give you the Spirit, who will make you wise and reveal God to you, so that you will know him. ¹⁸ I ask that your minds may be opened to see his light, so that you will know the hope to which he has called you, how rich are blessings he promises his people, ¹⁹ and how great is his power. This power working in us is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ which raised Christ from death.



GOSPEL: Luke 6: 20 – 31 (GNT)

²⁰ Jesus looked at his disciples and said,
“Happy are you poor;
the Kingdom of God is yours!
²¹ “Happy are you who are hungry now;
you will be filled!
“Happy are you who weep now;
you will laugh!
²² “Happy are you when people hate you,
reject you, insult you, and say that you
are evil, all because of the Son of Man!

²³ Be glad when that happens and dance for joy, because a great reward is kept for you in heaven. For their ancestors did the very same things to the prophets.

²⁴ “But how terrible for you who are rich now;

you have had your easy life!

²⁵ “How terrible for you who are full now;

you will go hungry!

“How terrible for you who laugh now;
you will mourn and weep!

²⁶ “How terrible when all people speak well of you; their ancestors said the very same things about the false prophets.

²⁷ “But I tell you who hear me: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, ²⁸ bless those who curse you, and pray for those who mistreat you.

²⁹ If anyone hits you on one cheek, let him hit the other one too; if someone takes your coat, let him have your shirt as well. ³⁰ Give to everyone who asks you for something, and when someone takes what is yours, do not ask for it back. ³¹ Do for others just what you want them to do for you.
