## **The Rt Revd & Rt Hon. Dame Sarah Mullally DBE appointed as 106<sup>th</sup> Archbishop of Canterbury**



His Majesty The King has been graciously pleased to approve the appointment of the Right Revd and Right Hon. Dame Sarah Mullally DBE as the 106<sup>th</sup> Archbishop of Canterbury.

The College of Canons of Canterbury will now be convened to elect Bishop Mullally – she will, however, be the only candidate. This election signifies the approval of the Diocese. Following this a Confirmation of Election will take place (probably at St. Paul's Cathedral). This ceremony signifies the affirmation of the wider Church. At this stage the Bishop becomes Archbishop and is admitted to the temporalities (i.e. legal possession) of the See of Canterbury.

In due course, the Archbishop's enthronement will take place in Canterbury Cathedral when she will be placed in the throne of St. Augustine.
