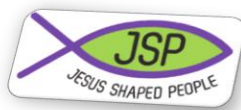




## St. Helen's Northwich Welcome!

When it is time for Communion, please come up to the altar - children, too! Stand or kneel (most people stand) along the edge of the altar platform, beginning from the right. To receive a blessing simply bow your head. For communion please cup your hands to receive the bread. The chalice containing wine will be handed to you. If you prefer not to drink from the common cup, simply decline the chalice. Please do not dip the bread in the wine. The Church of England believes that receiving either is the same as receiving both.
