Eco Top Tip

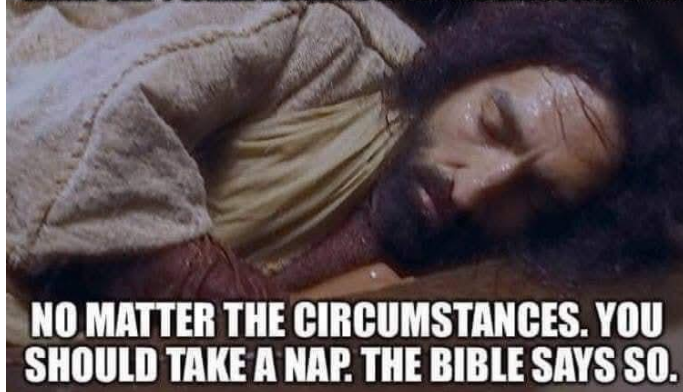
Draft proof your home to stop losing heat.

More church terminology

- **Christening**

Another word for baptism, especially of children.

- **Church Representation Rules**

A book of rules and guidelines for those involved in parochial, diocesan and national Church governance. [Read them here.](#)

- **Churchwarden**

The leading lay officer in a parish (at least two are appointed).

- **Clergy**

The general name for all ordained ministers.

- **Collective Worship**

A daily act of worship in schools, typically 'wholly or mainly of a broadly Christian character', providing the opportunity for prayer and reflection.

- **Common Worship**

The name for a family of volumes which, together with the Book of Common Prayer, make up the official liturgical resource of the Church of England.

- **Communion**

- a) the sacramental sharing of bread and wine by the faithful, following the example given in the Last Supper of Christ with his disciples;
- b) a service in which Holy Communion is received.

- **Communion in one kind**

Taking communion through only receiving the bread and not the wine.

- **Confirmation**

A service in which a person who has been baptized affirms their faith and receives prayer as the bishop lays hands on them.

- **Congregation**

A group of Christians who gather for prayer and worship
