15 minutes of silent prayer followed by Compline First Thursday of each month at 8pm








LIVING IN LOVE & FAI[†]H


Sing For Joy



Roll up your sleeves for our autumn vaccination clinic

Save the date:

Willingham (Octagon) Community Hub is hosting an immunisation clinic for local people on **Monday November 3**, 10am to 12noon.

We're working with the Community & School-Age Immunisation Team that covers Cambridgeshire & Peterborough.

The team plan to offer vaccinations to adults aged 65+.

COVID - 75 and over or 18-74 years if severely immunosuppressed

FLU - 65 and over

PPV (Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Vaccine) - 65 and over

Shingles - 70-79 years


RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus)- RSV - 75-79 years

Flu and shingles vaccines may be given to 60-65-year-olds based on health conditions or medications.

There is no charge for the immunisations and your health records will updated on a national system which gets uploaded to all GP records.

Our friendly hub team will have the kettle on for refreshments so please do stay on and have a cuppa and a chat with us and find out more about our free community support.
