Following in the footsteps of the Saints . . .



#### Saint Teresa of Avila, Teacher of the Faith 1582

Saint Teresa of Ávila was a Spanish Carmelite nun, mystic, and reformer. Dissatisfied with the lax practices of her order, she founded the Discalced Carmelites, promoting a life of prayer, poverty, and simplicity. She wrote spiritual classics like *The Interior Castle* and *The Way of Perfection*. Despite opposition, she founded 17 convents and became a leading figure in Catholic reform. Teresa was canonized in 1622 and named a Doctor of the Church in 1970.
