On **Remembrance Sunday**, we honour courage and sacrifice, praying that the peace for which so many died may take root in our own hearts and in the world.

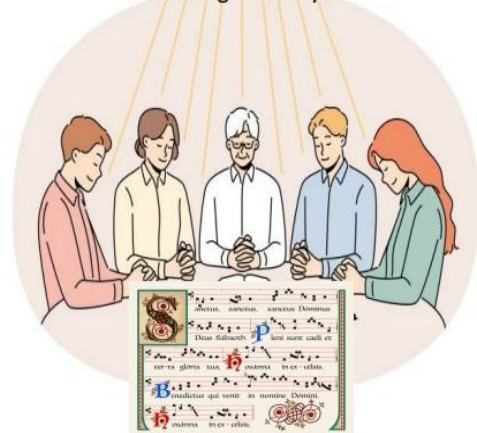
And at **Christ the King**, the final Sunday before Advent, we lift our eyes to the One whose reign is love, whose power is mercy, whose kingdom has no end.

This is for a short time of contemplation and prayer. If you wish, you can join in the Gregorian chanting— or sit in quiet meditation.

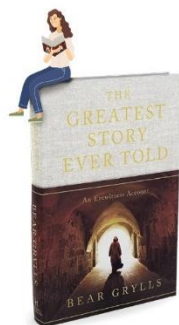
