On **Remembrance Sunday**, we honour courage and sacrifice, praying that the peace for which so many died may take root in our own hearts and in the world.


And at **Christ the King**, the final Sunday before Advent, we lift our eyes to the One whose reign is love, whose power is mercy, whose kingdom has no end.


From love remembered to love enthroned, this season leads us toward **Advent** — that quiet, powerful time when we prepare our hearts for Christ's coming.
