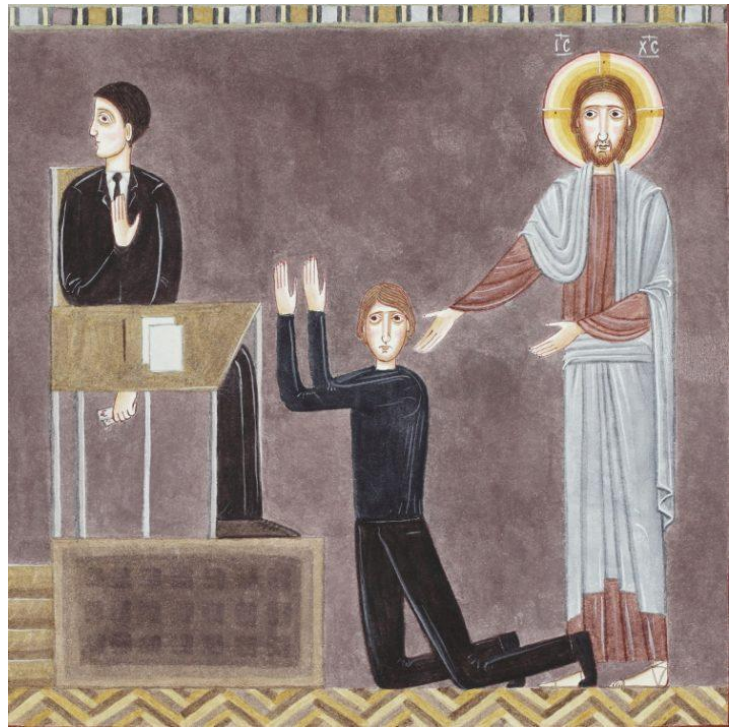

Temporary changes to the service pattern will affect the morning services on **26th October** and **16th November**: please check the listing on the back page.

St Bartholomew building works: Phase 1 will begin on **20th October 2025** and run until **9th March 2026**. This will see the creation of a new level access path and a doorway in through the north wall; a new internal lobby area incorporating the stained glass from the northwest window; two extra toilets; the old font relocated to near the main entrance steps; preparatory electrical work in advance of the installation (in Phase 2) of air source heat pumps. **For the duration of the project, the church will not be accessible on weekdays**, except for funerals and some pre-arranged dates. **Weekend use of the church will continue as normal except that the existing level access path and doorway will be unavailable**, but extra support will be provided for any who need help with the steps down from the main door. Music will be played on the piano while the organ is kept wrapped up for protection from building dust. We hope to keep disruption down to a minimum but apologise for any inconvenience this phase may cause.

King Alfred Weekend at St Bartholomew: our special commemorative service for the life and legacy of King Alfred takes place on **Sunday 26th October**, in the presence of the Mayor and Mayoress of Winchester, followed by the laying of flowers on the grave sites in Hyde Abbey Garden. Hyde900 events planned for the weekend include a **concert** by **Cambridge Renaissance Voices** (Friday 24th at 7.15pm), AGM (Saturday at 11am) and a **lecture** on the 'real' Magna Carta, marking the 800th anniversary of its final version (Saturday at 7pm).
