Church Work Party

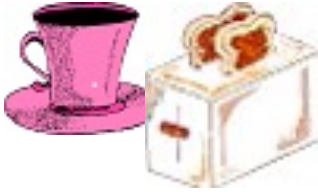
The next Church Work Party will be on Saturday 25th October at 9.00am. (This is a week later than usual because of the jigsaw festival – another busy month!!)

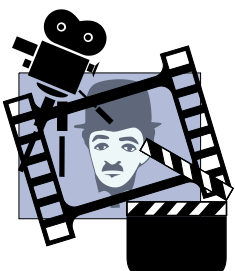
