Swindon Humanitarian Aid Partnership Appeal Shap-a-Wrap Christmas 2025

With our local shops filling up with Christmas decorations already, The Swindon Humanitarian Partnership (SHAP) is also looking ahead and planning to bring some joy to children in the worst hit areas of Ukraine. They are seeking donations of new/as new toys, wrapping paper, games, craft kits, crayons and stationary which will be gift wrapped, dispatched and distributed to areas and orphanages where they know they will be incredibly welcome. It is hard to avoid feeling powerless to assist in such an awful situation, but in Swindon we can do a bit to help make children's Christmas in Ukraine a little brighter.

The Community Centre@ Christ Church, Cricklade Street, Old Town, Swindon SN1 3HB is one of SHAP's two donation drop-off - points (the other is the Ellendune Community Centre in Wroughton) and regular collections at both show just how generous local people continue to be.

In November you have a chance to volunteer as well as donate to SHAP by joining one of their three fun public drop-in sessions and get wrapping. SHAP-a-Wrap family friendly drop-in-sessions will be held on Saturdays between 10am and 3pm on the 1st, 8th & 15th November at SHAP's warehouse near Swindon Railway Station (Unit 4b, Station Industrial Estate, Swindon SN1 5DE). SHAP volunteers are a friendly and welcoming team and if last year is anything to go by the drop in sessions will be jolly occasions

Many children have lost their father's fighting against the Russian invaders and tragically others have lost both parents. Attending school in basements underground and experiencing nights upset by constant sirens and explosions has become a reality for many of them. SHAP supports children and families in Ukraine throughout the year and rely on public and business support to do this. You can find more information and ways of supporting us on www.shapuk.org.

Background

SHAP is one of Christ Church's chosen charities and the church has supported SHAP since it was founded by the late Mike Bowden immediately following the Russian invasion of Ukraine in 2022. It was the first church to rally behind SHAP's Candles for Ukraine project which has since expanded to churches all over the country. SHAP has delivered 2,300 tonnes of aid as well as providing vehicles for vital humanitarian work.


