

HAPPY 190th ANNIVERSARY!! The *London City Mission* began with a prayer meeting. In 1835 a group of dedicated Christian men saw the terrible need and deprivation on the streets of London and prayed. They wanted to help, practically and spiritually; to introduce men, women and children to Jesus. Since launching a partnership approach, where a small team of missionaries go into a church and help them to engage in outreach, and begin other activities, they have helped over 100 churches make thousands of new connections with folk in

their neighbourhoods. With over **9 million people** in London speaking over **300 languages**, help has been given to churches where lots of folk of other faiths, Muslims, Hindus, etc live nearby. **The world has come to London!** Please **pray for missionaries and their families** as they live and work in our capital. Heating and the South Door

The heating is now on intermittently on the premises and will be set accordingly on a day-by-day basis. At this time of year it is sometimes difficult to predict the level needed and there will inevitably be days where it was 'not on' when needed, or 'on' when not needed, as the temperature can fall guickly or rise unexpectedly.

The South Door (the entrance along the footpath) will be **closed after Sunday 9th November** to ensure that the church remains warm and comfortable throughout the winter period. Feedback from last year was generally more positive about the temperature. Access to the services on Sundays will be through the Old Road reception doors only. Please leave the car park and Old Road parking for those who really need it.
