
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give thanks and praise.


In the same way, after supper he took the cup and gave you thanks; he gave it to them, saying:


Great is the mystery of faith:


Family News

We have an anchor that keeps the soul steadfast and sure while the billows roll fastened to the rock which cannot move grounded firm and deep in the Saviour's love.





The Blessing and Dismissal




