Our Bereavement Service - All Souls' Service 2nd November 2025

Each year at All Souls we gather for a special service of remembrance. It is a gentle and reflective time when we pause to remember those who have died – members of our families, our friends, and others whose lives have touched ours. During the service we hear words of comfort and hope, light candles in memory of loved ones, and bring our sadness and gratitude before God.

For many, this service offers a space to grieve and to give thanks in equal measure. It reminds us that it is good and healthy to remember, and that we do not walk through loss alone. In the quietness of shared prayer and music, we find that our memories can become blessings, and that God's promise of eternal life brings comfort and peace.

Whether your loss is recent or from long ago, you are warmly invited to come. Simply being together—listening, praying, remembering—helps us feel surrounded by a community that cares. All Souls reminds us that love never ends, and that God's light continues to shine, even through our sorrow.

<u>Prayer Walks and Services – Walking in Faith and Hope through St</u> Ninian's Parish

Our Prayer Walk and Services invite us to step out together in faith, praying for our community, the world, and one another. As we walk through the parish of St Ninians, we will pause to pray at key points, reflecting each time one of the the four priorities that shape the life and mission of the Diocese of Durham.

Our first one begins by praying for **growing Christian communities**, asking God to deepen our discipleship and strengthen the witness of local churches. We will begin at St Ninians, walk to St Annes Catholic Church and walk through some of the parish back to St Ninians incorporating Craigielea where we hold a regular service. This walk is 2 miles and will take 40 minutes.

The second one will focus on **children**, **young people**, **and families**, giving thanks for their energy and creativity, and seeking God's blessing on our schools and youth work.

The third one will lead us to places where we can appreciate the beauty of creation, reminding us of our call to **care for God's world** and to live more sustainably. Finally, the last one will focus on those affected by hardship and inequality, committing ourselves to **challenge poverty and injustice** with compassion and courage.

Each walk concludes with a short service of thanksgiving and listening to God — a reminder that every step we take in prayer helps to build God's kingdom here and now.
