Today's readings are Luke 18: 1-8 and 2 Timothy 3: 14-4:5

Keith writes...

In today's Gospel Jesus tells the story of a widow seeking justice against someone who had wronged her. At this time widows were particularly vulnerable, having no man to speak for them or take care of them in a society that granted women almost no independence of action. The judge in this case is also godless and uncaring but the widow continues to make her plea until she wears him out and he relents, making a judgement in her favour. Jesus says that even an unjust judge may be worn down by persistence, even by the powerless, so how much more should we expect from one who sees us as beloved children?

The purpose of this story is to encourage us to prayer in a spirit of persistence and faith. We are not approaching a capricious god (like the gods of the Greeks) or a curmudgeonly and perhaps corrupt legal official. We are the friends and family of Jesus, the sons and daughters of our heavenly Father. We can be sure that God will grant us justice.
