David Chapman was called home to be with the Lord on Wednesday 8th October 2025, in Colchester General Hospital. Please pray for the family at this difficult time.

It is with sadness that we announce the death of our dear friend, **Terry Puttick**, on Friday 17th October, after suffering from cancer for more than two years. He was well known to St Mary's for his Toy Service visits over many years, often with his young son Samuel, who was later employed as our Children and Families Worker. At the annual Christmas Toy Services, Terry would update the congregation with news of London City Mission's work, memorably using a scroll of wallpaper filled with illustrations drawn by his wife Liz. Over the years, he probably received thousands of toys donated by us, which he would take back to London to be distributed to families in disadvantaged areas, in contact with LCM.

Terry joined LCM several decades ago and spent well over 20 years as a missionary working on some of the toughest estates in London. Around the year 2000 he joined the Head Office Team and became Field Director of Ministries, looking after mission teams in the Tottenham and Enfield areas, and was also involved in ministry to the elderly until he retired.

We remember Liz in our prayers, along with their three adult children and many grandchildren in their sadness, giving thanks for Terry's enduring testimony to the love and faithfulness of God, and for the certainty that he is now in the presence of his Heavenly Father.
