Monday 20th October**



One of the activities at Harvest Messy Church will filling shoe boxes for the annual **Link to Hope Shoe Box Appeal**. As well as empty shoe boxes we also need some contents to put in them.

E.g.: Toothbrushes & toothpaste; candles & holders; soap and flannel; shampoo; moisturiser; hairbrush; A5 writing or colouring pads; crayons/pencils; small games (draughts, playing cards etc); small toys (yo-yo, skipping rope, toy cars, small teddy/doll etc); DIY hand tools; tape measures; wind up radio/torch; calculators; work gloves; lightweight head scarves; reading glasses; wooden cutlery; hot water bottle; socks & tights; sewing kit; scissors; nail clippers etc.

All clothing and toiletries must be new and unused. Soft toys must carry a CE/UKCA label.

Please bring your empty shoeboxes and box content donations to church and leave them in the Pilgrim Chapel.

Help to pack the boxes on Monday 20th will also be very welcome!
