Reflection By Jen White

Over this last week I have been 'confronted' with the beauty of the Trinity – whether through morning prayer, our Life group study or general reading and it made me think about the very first sermon I gave on Trinity Sunday 202. The beauty of creator God, Humble Son and Wise Holy Spirit who live within and around one another in a dance together – responding to each other and yet moving as one.

At that time I came across the following poem and felt I would like to share it with you this week.

Dave Hopwood - Trinity Poem

We have already secured £100,000 through fundraising and grants.




We are again planning to support T4U by making up shoeboxes to be sent to Eastern Europe.
