# More ways to pray

AT THE BEGINNING of next month, I'll be celebrating the end of my fifth year as Vicar here at St A's. Five years! I do hope you're encouraged by all that God has done among us since November 2020. I am! All glory to him.

Without doubt, the thing I am most encouraged by is the growth in our culture of prayer. We are unusual among churches here in town as having not one but three regular prayer gatherings each week. Our Kingdom Come nights of worship and prayer are simply electric. Our Half Nights of Prayer draw people from right across our town to pray for the rising generation. I say this not to brag – God has done it, not us - but it is remarkable and wonderful..

We're always looking for new ways to engage more of us in regular prayer together. New this autumn is a monthly Creative Prayer evening on Sundays. Sarah Stone's vision for this new prayer gathering grows out of Ephesians 2:10, "We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works.'
