#### What is Confirmation?

Confirmation is a special service where you make your own conscious decision to **re-commit and re-purpose yourself in the Christian journey**. It's an opportunity to affirm the promises made at your baptism and to receive prayer from the bishop for the strengthening of the Holy Spirit as you continue to grow in faith.

#### Service Details:

The Confirmation Service will take place on **Sunday 30th November at 4.00pm** at **St Andrew's Church, Romford**.
