This is the report from the judges

The overall impact of all parts of this church garden is excellent! The planting in all areas is very well thought out. The borders along the side of the front lawn and the planters around the church are well cared for and give a warm welcome to visitors. There are various attractive notices that provide information for visitors about the plants chosen and a range of other wildlife initiatives including the hedgehog hotel and development of the woodpile. A well-positioned sign gives a good report on the actions taken and management of the area at the back of the church, including the vegetable patch and the use of the compost heap. The area with cremated remains is very neat and tidy, with benches inviting visitors to sit and remember. The notices at the front give contact details and service information, and there is an explicit welcome, in six languages. This is clearly a much loved and extremely well cared for church garden, maintained to a very high standard. Very many thanks to all those who work hard to maintain and develop this very welcoming, special place.


Saturdays 1st and 3rd Walking group meet Holy Spirit 10am
