PRISONS WEEK starts on **Sunday 12th October**. It is when we pray for prisoners, their families, their victims, and all working in the Justice system. The display in church gives news of our local prisons, HMP/YOI Hollesley Bay & Warren Hill; and suggests new ways to support them.
