#### REFLECTIONS......REV.BEA ERSKINE

This Sunday we are coming to the end of the church year with the Feast of Christ the King. In Luke's gospel this week, it is hard to imagine a situation less regal. Crucifixion was the most lowly, brutal and agonising death, the sheer incongruity of 'feast and king' alongside the description of the final moments of Jesus' time on earth is almost incomprehensible. Deeply moving we would rather hide our faces than think about this shocking scene. But this Kingship is utterly different it is one of love, compassion, forgiveness and justice. Just imagine the sheer relief of the criminal in his agony when Jesus tells him he will be with him in Paradise.

As we pray for the coming of the Kingdom, the great rescue for humankind, when all will be made well, we can do so with the confidence that this King doesn't want us to suffer in the darkness of unknowing, but bring us into the light.

This week, as the days grow ever shorter, the nights colder and we head into winter and the coming of Advent, we can reflect that Jesus in his last moments on earth proclaimed a repentant sinner would be with him in Paradise. Christ the King; of hope, love and forgiveness.
