

## A Rocha UK Silver award; what next?

In 2022 Christ Church was awarded an A Rocha Eco Church silver award for the work we had done improving our carbon footprint, the biodiversity in our churchyard and our community engagement. We were rightly proud of this achievement as we were one of the first churches in the Diocese with a silver award. The jump from silver to gold, however, is a big one and we are in the process of getting back on track after the re-ordering.

The re-ordering in itself will help us enormously by reducing the fuel we use to heat and light the building. However we will need to quantify this by comparing figures for 2023 with 2025/6. The road to the gold award is made up of many small things which are achievable if the church family gets behind this. The Anglican Communion's fifth mark of mission states that we should strive to safeguard the integrity of creation and sustain and renew the life of the earth.

We have 2 eco-champions and welcome more people to support us. We are Angie Clarke and Anita Campbell and we can be contacted through <a href="mailto:fabric@dorechurch.org.uk">fabric@dorechurch.org.uk</a>
The community engagement part of the A Rocha award programme has been supported by our Local Mission Group. This group has helped such events as Rake and Cake, Adopt a Grave and Count on Nature.

With the help of Andy Patrick we have designed a poster to communicate how easy it is to help our efforts with small actions. We have inserted the poster here for you to read. Let us know if it is something you want to help out with or you have another idea for us. The PCC has agreed a Mission Action Plan and we are really pleased that achieving the gold award is on there under the heading "Social Transformation". Social transformation can come about with the small actions of many people. Isaiah 65 talks about new heavens and a new earth in verses 17-18, "Behold I will create new heavens and a new earth. The former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind. But be glad and rejoice forever in what I will create."
