God, our refuge and strength, bring near the day when wars shall cease and poverty and pain shall end, that earth may know the peace of heaven through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.

## PRINCIPAL READINGS

First reading: Ecclesiasticus 44. 1-15

- 44 So let us now give praise to godly men, our ancestors of generations past,
- <sup>2</sup> those whom the Lord honoured with great glory, in whom his greatness has been seen from the beginning of time.
- <sup>3</sup> There were some who ruled kingdoms, and some who were known for their strength. Some were wise advisers, and some spoke prophecies.
- <sup>4</sup> There were statesmen whose policies governed the people, rulers who issued decrees, scholars who spoke wise words, and those who used pointed proverbs,
- <sup>5</sup> poets, and composers of music,<sup>6</sup> rich and powerful men living peacefully at home.
- <sup>7</sup> All of these were famous in their own times, honoured by the people of their day.

- <sup>8</sup> Some of them left a reputation, and people still praise them today.
- <sup>9</sup> There are others who are not remembered, as if they had never lived, who died and were forgotten, they, and their children after them.
- <sup>10</sup> But we will praise these godly men, whose righteous deeds have never been forgotten.
- <sup>11</sup> Their reputations will be passed on to their descendants, and this will be their inheritance.
- <sup>12</sup> Their descendants continue to keep the covenant and always will, because of what their ancestors did.
- <sup>13</sup> Their family line will go on forever, and their fame will never fade.
- <sup>14</sup> Their bodies were laid to rest, but their reputations will live forever.
- <sup>15</sup> Nations will tell about their wisdom, and God's people will praise them.

## Gospel: Luke 20. 27-38

<sup>27</sup> Some of the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came to Jesus with a question. <sup>28</sup> "Teacher," they said, "Moses wrote for us that if a man's brother dies and leaves a wife but no children, the man must marry the widow and raise up offspring for his brother. <sup>29</sup> Now there were seven brothers. The first one married a woman and died childless. <sup>30</sup> The second <sup>31</sup> and then the third married her, and in the same way the seven died, leaving no children. <sup>32</sup> Finally, the woman died too. <sup>33</sup> Now then, at the resurrection whose wife will she be, since the seven were married to her?"

<sup>34</sup> Jesus replied, "The people of this age marry and are given in marriage. <sup>35</sup> But those who are considered worthy of taking part in the age to come and in the resurrection from the dead will neither marry nor be given in marriage, <sup>36</sup> and they can no longer die; for they are like the angels. They are God's children, since they are children of the resurrection. <sup>37</sup> But in the account of the burning bush, even Moses showed that the dead rise, for he calls the Lord 'the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' <sup>38</sup> He is not the God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."
