Eco Tips – Here are some ideas to help you make 'enjoying nature' more intentional in 2025

COP30 is the 30th annual Conference of the Parties to the United Nations climate change framework, starting this week in Belém, Brazil, right in the heart of the Amazon. Voices from the global south are calling for a decisive move from promises to practice, an end to the fossil fuel era and for the promised Loss and Damage Fund, for poorer nations most affected by

climate change, to become operational. Pray that policy makers and world leaders will be moved and act to protect God's beautiful creation. Pray for faith groups to be well represented and their voice heard.

Eco Tips

Take an audit of your individual or household carbon footprint and repeat each year to see if you can reduce it! There are lots of ways to do this, from switching energy suppliers to changes in your diet. Some great tools to use are available, for example the carbon calculators provided by Climate Stewards at climatestewards.org/carboncalculators/, and Creation Care creationcare.org.uk, offers a specific resource for households giving ideas and helping you track your progress. As you look at different areas of your life, offer each area or action to God as an offering.
