

## Christmas Afternoon Tea: Monday 15 December, 2-4pm

### Kingston Vale Trust

Each year Kingston Vale Trust (charity number 205433) makes grants for the benefit of the people living within the parish of St John the Baptist Kingston Vale. (The parish consists of Kingston Vale, Putney Vale and parts of Kingston Hill - exact details of the boundary are available on request). The Trust intends to make grants of between £500 and £15,000 for 2026.

The trustees make grants once per year, assessing any completed application forms received by the end of November 2025. Grants will be awarded to the successful applicant(s) by the end of December 2025. Applicants must complete the application form and return it to the parish office. 
