This Sunday is known as 'Christ the King Sunday. It comes before journey of Advent, when we remember the sovereignty of Jesus, His greatness and majesty over all things. How he is the Lord of lords who came to us in such humility, and revealed His love.

As we proclaim the Kingdom of Jesus, the world is in such turmoil. We might ask questions of our leaders, those who are set in authority, those who call us to follow, of their commitment to justice and peace.
