Fire Evacuation Procedures

On discovering a fire:

- First seek help and raise the alarm by shouting FIRE and call 999
- Stop all activities
- PCC members present assess that all persons can evacuate the area and help guide people to nearest safe exit following fire exit signs checking building is empty
- Use fire extinguisher if able to
- Steer clear of hazards
- Move out and away from building to meeting point – Station Rd public footpath
- Do not re-enter the building without an "ALL CLEAR"
