Working Groups Overview - Minster Community Formation

I. Engagement Working Group

Explores how churches feel about forming a Minster Community, especially around collaboration across differences. It will gather hopes, concerns, and openness to working together, then share insights and questions with the Coordinating Group.

2. Finance, Generosity & Church Buildings

Assesses church finances and buildings—current status, viability of stipendiary ministry, and potential for shared use. It will also explore generosity culture and identify opportunities for collaboration, feeding findings into the Co-ordinating Group.

3. Growing Faith, Schools, Discipleship & Mission

Gathers observations and suggestions to inform the Co-ordinating Group's proposal for how the Minster Community might work together.

4. Ministry, New Communities, Geography & Resources

Maps out who is ministering (lay and ordained), where resources are strong or lacking, and how churches are nurturing new leaders.
