Today's readings are Matthew 24: 36-44 and Isaiah 2: 1-5

Di writes....

The first Sunday of Advent – and back into purple colours we go; a season of penitence, a season of preparation. No flowers in the church – we do decorate with greenery as our Advent Ring demonstrates, but certainly no flowers; we wait for those to blossom on Christmas Day. Waiting is what these next four weeks are all about as we watch and prepare. It is the season of waking up and looking forward – it should interrupt our day to day lives. In the Epistle reading set for today - which we didn't read this morning – Paul writes to the Romans that they must wake up and take notice (Romans 13.11). And in our reading from Isaiah and the Psalm set for today we are invited to look to the future (Ps 122). A future which celebrates the first coming of Christ and looks forward to the second coming. And so as we risk getting absorbed by the busyness of this time of year, may we remember to stop and recall the real purpose of these four weeks of preparation.

Lord our God, make us watchful and keep us faithful as we await the coming of your Son our Lord, that when he shall appear he may not find us sleeping in sin but active in his service and joyful in his promise. Amen

The first is to subscribe to 'New Daylight', a publication by The Bible Reading Fellowship, which provides suggested readings with notes to help you make sense of the passage. Fanny Cross can obtain these for you - 01932 345415 or fannycross9420@outlook.com.

An alternative would be to obtain a copy of 'Reflections for Daily Prayer' which is published by Church House Publishing. This indicates readings for every day of the year from the Church of England lectionary with a reflection upon the reading. This can be obtained from Amazon or Church House Bookshop online.
