

- ensure those who need to be trained in safeguarding get trained (Though the PSO does not do the training),
- see that the parish makes progress in becoming compliant with Diocesan safeguarding policies,
- respond properly to any safeguarding concern that is raised.

The Red Chair - You may have noticed a red chair standing in the prayer corner. This is to mark the United Nations 16 Days of Activism on Gender Based Violence Against Women and Girls. Mothers' Union are involved in this annually and our participation is labelled "Rise Up". which stands for Restore, Inform, Support, Empower, Unite & Pray. The chair represents the space left by those women and girls who have been killed at the hands of an intimate partner or family member. Globally this happens every 11 minutes! On Saturday 4 MU members from our branch joined a silent walk in the centre of Eastbourne from Victoria Place to Banking Corner to raise

awareness of this growing and alarming situation in all walks of life. At the end of the walk we heard a very moving story from a previous victim who is now labels herself as a survivor. Please spend a moment in the prayer corner while the chair is there. Jacky Clark
