Later, it's St Winifred's **Christmas Fair**, from 11:00am - 3:00pm.





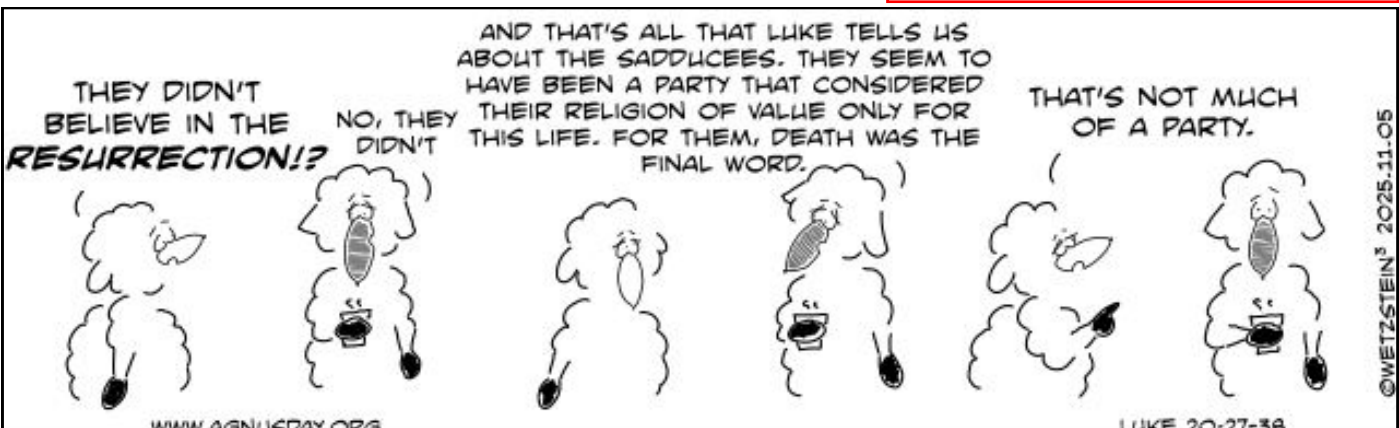
