
Sermon - 'New from Old'



Battle Belongs



Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace.




This is the table, not of the church, but of our Lord. It is made ready for those who love him and for those who want to love him more. So come you who have much faith and you who have little.






Receiving the bread and wine


Now may the Spirit of God who brooded over the waters and brought order out of chaos
